



Cleaning Instructions – Plexiglass Acrylic

TO CLEAN PLEXIGLASS ACRYLIC:

- Wash with plenty of nonabrasive soap or detergent and water, using a bare hand to feel and dislodge any caked dirt or mud.
- A soft, grit-free cloth, sponge or chamois may be used, but only as a means of carrying water to the sheet.
- Dry with a clean damp chamois.

FOR INTERIOR INSTALLATIONS (where water cannot be used freely):

- First, lightly dust (not wipe) plexiglass acrylic with a soft, clean cloth; then carefully wipe with a soft, wet cloth or chamois.
- Keep cloth or chamois free of grit by frequent rinsing in clean water to avoid scratching.
- Grease and oil may be removed with kerosene or aliphatic naphtha (no aromatic content).

DON'TS:

- Do not use hard, rough cloths that will scratch the plexiglass acrylic.
- Do not use solvents such as acetone, benzene, carbon tetrachloride, fire extinguisher fluid, dry-cleaning fluid, and lacquer thinners.
- Do not use window sprays or kitchen scouring compounds.
